


How to add variable product in WordPress:

Step 1: Managing products attributes

Before creating the variations for products, the attributes need to be set up. To do so you need to:


1. Choose **Attributes** in the left hand menu.




Slug

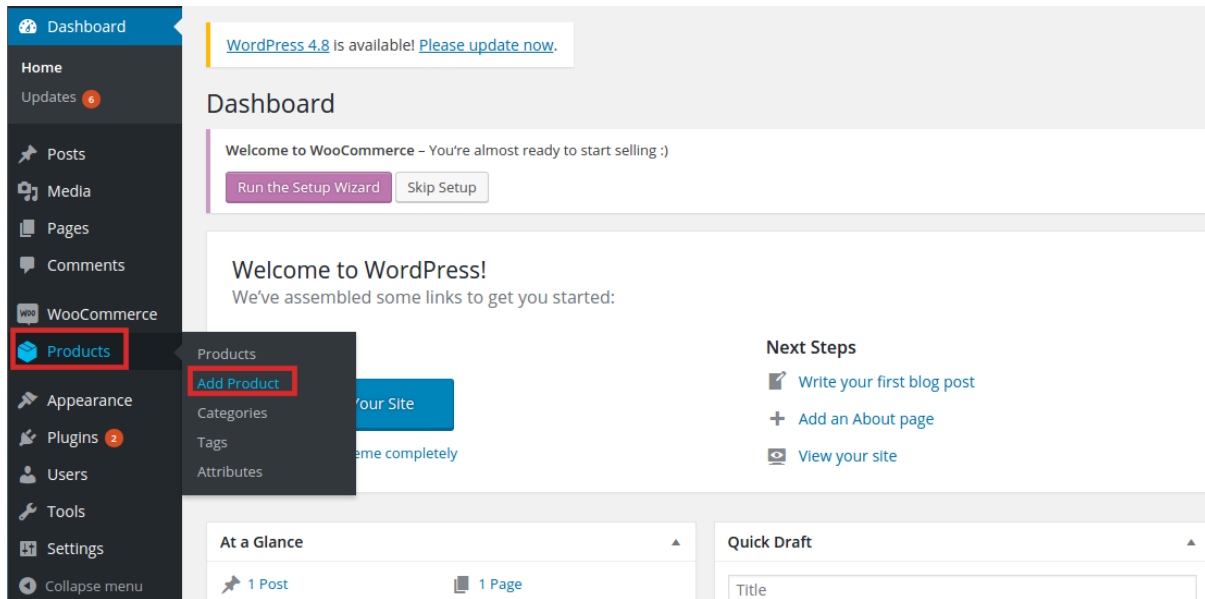

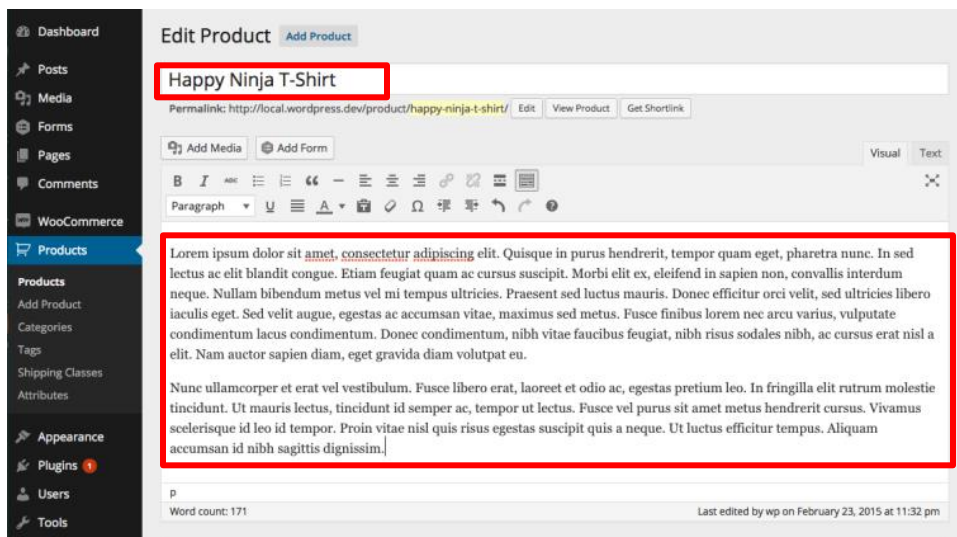
6. Then click the drop down menu under **Parent** and select the attribute you added earlier (e.g. Sizes).
7. Select **"Add New Size"**.

Step 2: Adding the product

1. Go to the left hand menu and click on **Products>Add Product** or **Edit** an existing one.




2. Enter the **products name** and the product's description.





Step 3: Adding attributes for products

1. Pick **“Variable product”** from the **Product Data** dropdown. Choose one from the list (e.g. Sizes) and click **Add**.



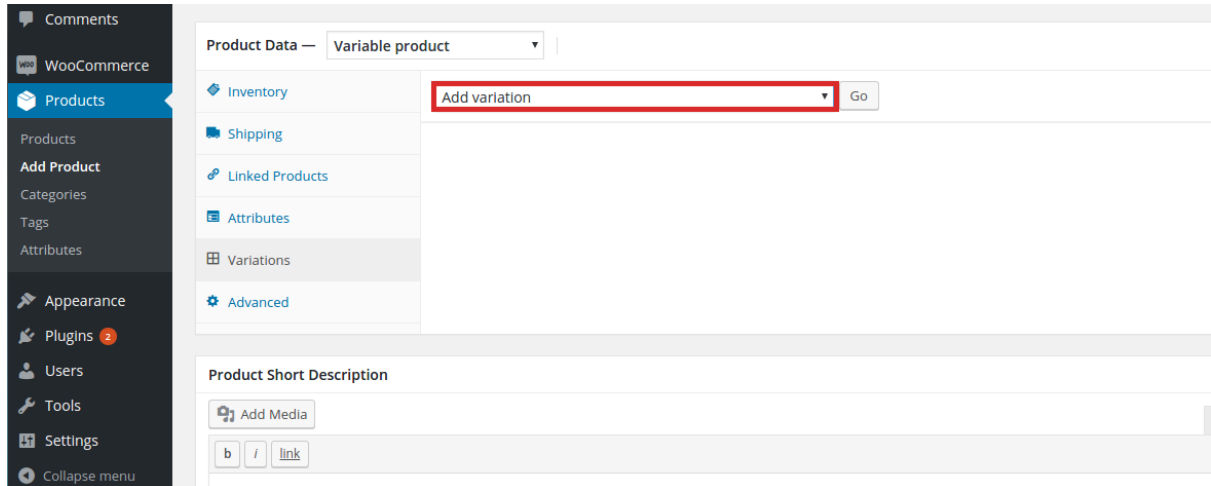

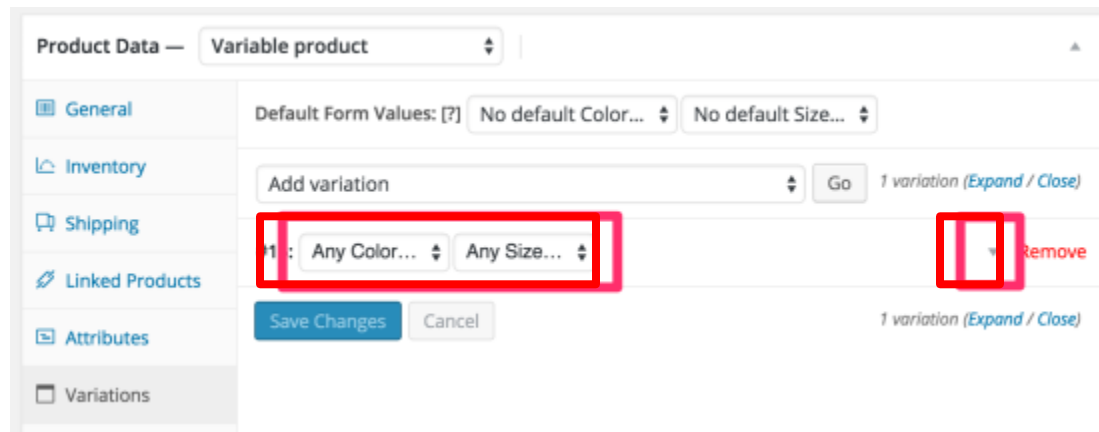
Keep in mind that you`re able to add an attribute for one product only if this product has unique variations. To do it, go to **Product > Add Product**, choose the **Attributes** tab and pick up the **Custom product** attribute. Then, follow the above step-by step instructions.

Step 4: Adding variations

1. Go to the **Variations** section. Choose “**Add variation**” from the dropdown menu and press **Go**.



2. Next, choose the attributes for your variation.



Note: If your navigations exceed 10, use the buttons to navigate you through list.

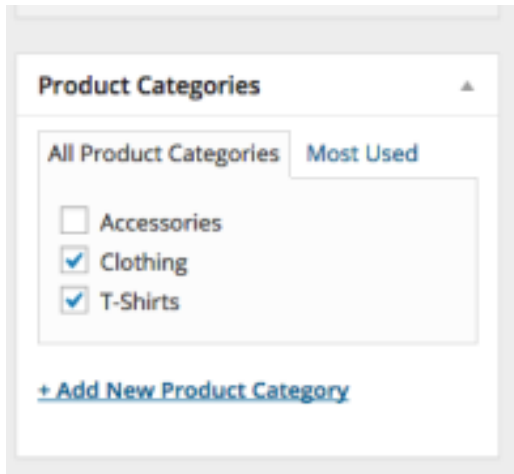
